**Comb Honey - cut Comb (sections of 12 oz. Each)**

5. Light cut comb
6. Dark cut, comb
7. Chunk - (2 pounds, in 1 pound glass containers).

**Extracted Honey (2 one pound jars)**

8. Extra white
9. White
10. Extra light amber
11. Light amber
12. Dark amber
13. Finely crystalized or creamed (in glass, 2 containers, approx., 1 pound each.)

**Beeswax**

14. Commercial (single piece pure beeswax not less than 3 pounds)
15. Molded or designed (not less than 1 pound)
16. Dipped candles (one pair made of 100% pure beeswax)
17. Molded candles (tapers), one pair made of 100% beeswax

**MAPLE SYRUP AND MAPLE PRODUCTS**

- Syrup is to be judges on flavor, color, density, and clarity.
- Sugar is to be judged on flavor, appearance and texture.
