All rides require just 1 ticket and are operational Tues. thru Fri. 6pm to 11pm and Sat. 5pm to 11pm.
Rides tickets are \$2.50/each -or- \$20 for 10 tickets. An all night wristband can be purchased for \$15.

General Admission is FREE. There is a \$2 / vehicle, per night suggested parking donation. Admission is charged for Track events.

Pit Admission is \$15 (must be 18 or older for Pit) • Grandstand Admission is \$8 Adults & \$4 Kids for the Demolition Derby. Friday's ATV Drags & Street Class Truck Drags are \$5 for everyone. Truck & Tractor Pull is \$10 Adults & \$5 Kids • Mud Bog & Mud Drag Racing is \$12 Adults & \$6 Kids • **Kids 4 & under are FREE!**
